BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA COMMISSION ON CHILDREN AND YOUTH

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of ____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth by law.

OFFICE OF HANDICAPPED CONCERNS

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of Handicapped Concerns from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of ____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of Handicapped Concerns by law.

HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Human Rights Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the

General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Human Rights Commission by law.

INDIAN AFFAIRS COMMISSION

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Indian Affairs Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Indian Affairs Commission by law.

SECTION 5. The appropriations made by Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1996. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1996, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
