BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA COMMISSION ON CHILDREN AND YOUTH

SECTION 1. From all sources of revenue during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, expenditures for the following categories by the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, shall not exceed:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Forty-five Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-eight Dollars (\$45,428.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996.

The Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitation, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
