(educational entities - appropriation - Oklahoma State
Regents for Higher Education - effective date -
emergency)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of ____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution to the institutions of The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education for the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovation or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

PHYSICIAN MANPOWER TRAINING COMMISSION

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Physician Manpower Training Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of ____ Dollars

(\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission by law.

SECTION 3. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 4. The appropriation made by Section 2 of this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1996. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1996, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
