An Act relating to environment and natural resources;
authorizing possession, use, manufacture, purchase,
installation, transportation and sale of
chlorofluorocarbons; removing liability of certain
persons and state agencies, officials and political
subdivisions; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-5-106.1 of Title 27A, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A person may possess, use, manufacture, purchase, install,
transport or sell chlorofluorocarbons.

B. The possession, use, manufacture, purchase, installation,
transportation or sale of chlorofluorocarbons, pursuant to this
section, does not subject any person, the Department of
Environmental Quality, any other agency or official of this state or
any political subdivision of this state to any penalty, fine,
retaliatory action or other punitive measure.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
