An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.

1991, Section 12-203, which relates to head lamps;  
modifying certain height limitations; and providing  
an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 12-203, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 12-203. (a) Every motor vehicle other than a motorcycle  
or motor-driven cycle shall be equipped with at least two head lamps  
with at least one on each side of the front of the motor vehicle,  
which head lamps shall comply with the requirements and limitations  
set forth in this chapter.

(b) Every motorcycle and every motor-driven cycle shall be  
equipped with at least one and not more than two head lamps which  
shall comply with the requirements and limitations of this chapter.

(c) After the effective date of this ~~Code~~ act, every head lamp  
upon every motor vehicle, including every motorcycle and motor-  
driven cycle, shall be located at a height measured from the center  
of the head lamp of not more than fifty-four (54) inches nor less

than ~~twenty-four (24)~~ twenty-two (22) inches to be measured as set forth in Section 12-202 of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
