An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.  
1991, Section 108.1, which relates to jurisdiction  
of cities and towns to regulate traffic on boundary  
lines; modifying area in which cities and towns may  
enforce traffic ordinances; and providing an  
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 108.1, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 108.1 Any city or town may promulgate, adopt and  
enforce ordinances governing and regulating the operation of motor  
vehicles and other traffic upon roads, streets and highways ~~that~~  
~~form~~ within the boundary ~~line~~ lines of such city or town, subject to  
the provisions of Section 15-101 et seq. of Title 47 of the Oklahoma  
Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
