An Act relating to motor vehicles; requiring courts to review traffic records of certain defendants; requiring collection of driver license of a person whose license has been suspended or revoked; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-102 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Every magistrate or judge of a court shall review the traffic record of any defendant before the court for an alleged violation of a traffic law or ordinance. If the traffic record indicated that the driver license is under suspension or revocation, the magistrate shall collect the license from the person and forward the license to the Department of Public Safety.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
