An Act relating to community service sentences;  
providing municipal immunity from workers'  
compensation liability for persons serving sentence  
of community service imposed by municipal court;  
providing for codification; providing an effective  
date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 27-122.3 of Title 11, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Workers' Compensation Act shall not apply to a person while  
that person is performing activities pursuant to a sentence of  
community service.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 28-123.1 of Title 11, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Workers' Compensation Act shall not apply to a person while  
that person is performing activities pursuant to a sentence of  
community service.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1996.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
