BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-106.1 of Title 43A, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services
shall reimburse a county sheriff for any transportation services
provided by the sheriff's office pursuant to Title 43A of the
Oklahoma Statutes at the mileage rate provided in the State Travel
Reimbursement Act.

B. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services
shall pay a county sheriff Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per hour or
provide for a different amount by contract for transportation
services provided pursuant to Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes
which require an employee of the sheriff's office to travel outside
the jurisdiction of that sheriff's office.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
