An Act relating to public health and safety;
requiring the Oklahoma Health Authority to amend
state Medicaid plan for certain funding source for
payment of temporary managers or state monitors for
long-term care services and community-based service
provider facilities; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5020.1 of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall amend the state
Medicaid plan to provide a funding source for payment of temporary
managers or state monitors in facilities certified to provide long-
term care services and community-based service provider facilities
under Medicaid, upon request of the Department of Human Services
pursuant to 42 U.S.C.A., Section 1396r(h)(z).

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
