A Concurrent Resolution proclaiming the week of April 3 through 9, 1995, as Public Health Week; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, public health education, research, and service preserve and enhance the health status of Oklahomans and are among the highest priorities of the College of Public Health at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center; and

WHEREAS, public health professionals and others who promote public health play important roles in providing for the health and welfare of our citizens, and their efforts undertaken with genuine concern and compassion are worthy of widespread recognition and appreciation; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Department of Health and the College of Public Health are celebrating the first full week in April as Public Health Week; and

WHEREAS, Public Health Week also recognizes the coalition of public and private organizations, foundations, academia, and health-related enterprises that are working to promote healthy behaviors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature hereby proclaims April 3 through 9, 1995, as Public Health Week in this state and urges all citizens to join in this important observance.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor, the College of Public Health at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center, and the Oklahoma State Board of Health.
