A Concurrent Resolution memorializing the service of Sergeant Marvin Newberry of the 103rd Division, 410th Regiment of the United States Army; designating the bridge crossing North Boggy Creek on State Highway 131 as "The Marvin Newberry Bridge"; directing the Department of Transportation to place appropriate markers; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Sergeant Marvin Newberry of Atoka County was a member of the 103rd Division, 410th Regiment of the United States Army during World War II; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Marvin Newberry, while proudly serving his country in France as a member of the 103rd Division, 410th Regiment of the United States Army, was killed near Epinal, France, on April 7, 1945; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Marvin Newberry gave the ultimate sacrifice while dutifully serving country, state and mankind during World War II.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the bridge over North Boggy Creek on State Highway 131 in Atoka County be and is hereby designated "The Marvin Newberry Bridge" as a lasting testimonial to the courage and sacrifice of Sergeant Marvin Newberry in the performance of his duties as a member of the 103rd Division, 410th Regiment of the United States Army.

THAT the Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon said bridge bearing the name "The Marvin Newberry Bridge" and an appropriate designation to memorialize the service of Sergeant Marvin Newberry to his country.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Department of Transportation and Mr. Johnny J. Self of Atoka County.
