A Concurrent Resolution authorizing the Commission for Human Services to enter into a certain lease agreement for certain office space; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires the board of county commissioners of each county to furnish quarters for local units of the Department of Human Services unless it is determined that adequate or suitable quarters from the county are not available or obtainable; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Pottawatomie County, Oklahoma, does not have adequate resources to meet its legal obligation; and

WHEREAS, Pottawatomie County, Oklahoma, is undertaking a project via the Pottawatomie County Development Authority, to provide office space to the Department of Human Services through the building of an office building which it will subsequently lease to the Department of Human Services; and

WHEREAS, Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires that this type of transaction must receive legislative approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT in order to offer accessible and comprehensive services to clients of the Department of Human Services from Pottawatomie County, Oklahoma, the Commission for Human Services is hereby authorized to enter into a lease agreement with the Pottawatomie County Development Authority to provide office space to the Department of Human Services for the location of the local county office of the Department of Human Services in Pottawatomie County, Oklahoma.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Commission for Human Services and the Board of County Commissioners of Pottawatomie County, Oklahoma.
