A Concurrent Resolution proclaiming the Legislature's support of a Sports Museum in the City of Guthrie; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma evolved amidst five land runs of which the Cherokee outlet was the largest single competitive event in American history, when 100,000 future Oklahomans raced for seven million acres; and

WHEREAS, professional sports, a form of the legacy of that early competitiveness, teaches many of the enduring values of our society and rewards its participants with good health; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma supports organizations striving to preserve our rich cultural heritage of sports at the local, regional, national and international levels; and

WHEREAS, the recently created Oklahoma Sports Museum Association of Guthrie will honor all Oklahoma professional and Olympic athletes who have garnered recognition for Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, a museum is a way to provide an educational and motivational program that will encourage young people to stay away from drugs, alcohol, and any substance or activity that might prevent them from using their minds and abilities to the fullest extent possible; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature seeks to encourage the establishment of an Oklahoma Sports Museum in the Historic District of the City of Guthrie in this our 89th year of statehood.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature resolves to support the Oklahoma Sports Museum Association in its endeavor to establish a museum in the City of Guthrie.

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature hereby recognizes the Oklahoma Sports Museum Association as the foundation for the official Sports Museum of Oklahoma as it recognizes all professional and Olympic athletes of this great state and uses its positive influence to help the young people of Oklahoma.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Mayor of the City of Guthrie, and to the members of the Board of Trustees and the Advisory Board of the Oklahoma Sports Museum Association.
