A Concurrent Resolution relating to public health and safety; requiring the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety, the Oklahoma Tax Commission, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to study certain issues related to personal watercraft and boat operators; requiring report; and providing for distribution.

WHEREAS, there are more than 209,000 boats and jet skis registered in the State of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, there have been raised serious concerns regarding the safety of boating recreation on the public waters of the State of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, there have been a number of accidents involving jet skis on Oklahoma's waterways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety, the Oklahoma Tax Commission, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and the Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall conduct a study regarding the regulation and licensing of jet ski and boat operators in the State of Oklahoma.

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety, the Oklahoma Tax Commission, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and the

Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall submit a report to the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Governor which shall make recommendations for changes to the law implementing regulation and licensing of jet ski and boat operators in the State of Oklahoma.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the chief administrative officer of the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety, the Oklahoma Tax Commission, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and the Oklahoma Department of Commerce.
