BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA HISTORICAL SOCIETY

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Historical Society from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of Zero Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Historical Society by law.

SECTION 2. From all sources of revenue during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, expenditures for the following categories by the Oklahoma Historical Society shall not exceed:

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Historical Society by law shall be set by the Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-five Thousand Twenty Dollars (\$55,020.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996. The Oklahoma Historical Society for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

J.M. DAVIS MEMORIAL COMMISSION

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of Zero Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission by law.

SECTION 5. From all sources of revenue during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, expenditures for the following categories by the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission shall not exceed:

The salary of the Chief Administrative Officer shall not exceed Forty Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-eight Dollars (\$40,328.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996. The J.M. Davis Memorial Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

WILL ROGERS MEMORIAL COMMISSION

SECTION 7. There is hereby appropriated to the Will Rogers Memorial Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of Zero Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Will Rogers Memorial Commission by law.

SECTION 8. From all sources of revenue during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, expenditures for the following categories by the Will Rogers Memorial Commission shall not exceed:

SECTION 10. The appropriations made by Sections 1, 4, 7 and 8 of this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1996. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1996, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 11. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 12. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
