BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

GOVERNOR

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
30, 1996, the following amount or so much thereof as may be required
for the following purposes:

Personal Services, operating expenses and extraordinary protection of the state	\$0.00
For payment of official and necessary expenses during occupancy of the Governor's Mansion and to perform the duties of the Governor's Office pursuant to Section 7 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes	<u>0.00</u>

LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the amount of Zero Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Lieutenant Governor by law.

SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1996. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1996, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
