An Act relating to preservation of civil order and safety; making an appropriation to the Department of Civil Emergency Management; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Office of the State Fire Marshal; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Military Department; stating purpose; providing lapse date; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Civil Emergency Management from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of Zero Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Civil Emergency Management by law.

OFFICE OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the State Fire Marshal from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year

ending June 30, 1996, the sum of Zero Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the State Fire Marshal by law.

MILITARY DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of Zero Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma by law.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1996. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1996, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
