BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Conservation Commission by law shall be set by the Commission. The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed Fifty-one Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-six Dollars (\$51,566.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996. The Oklahoma Conservation Commission, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

DEPARTMENT OF MINES

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Mines by law shall be set by the Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed Forty-three Thousand Five Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$43,560.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996. The Department of Mines for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

OKLAHOMA WATER RESOURCES BOARD

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Water Resources Board by law shall be set by the Oklahoma Water Resources Board. The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed Fifty-nine Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-one Dollars (\$59,661.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996. The Oklahoma Water Resources Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

Full-time-equivalent Employees	90.0

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
