BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA COMMISSION ON CHILDREN AND YOUTH

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth by law.

SECTION 2. From all sources of revenue during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, expenditures for the following categories by the Oklahoma Commission for Children and Youth shall not exceed:
