BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

STATE ELECTION BOARD

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the State Election Board shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Election Board by law shall be set by the Secretary of the State Election Board. The salary of the Secretary of the State Election Board shall not exceed Sixty-four Thousand Three

Hundred Ninety-one Dollars (\$64,391.00) per annum, payable monthly
for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996.

SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the State Ethics Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Ethics Commission by law shall be set by the Executive Director of the Ethics Commission. The Ethics Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
