An Act funding law enforcement agencies; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Department of Public Safety; stating purposes; making an appropriation to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations; stating purpose; providing lapse date; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA STATE BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation by law.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Public Safety from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year

ending June 30, 1996, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Public Safety by law.

MEDICOLEGAL INVESTIGATIONS

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1996. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1996, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
