

ENGROSSED SENATE

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 500.5, which relates to the Administrative Procedures Act; authorizing certain state employees to use rental cars in lieu of commuter airplanes; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 500.5, is amended to read as follows:

Section 500.5 A. Reimbursement for automobiles leased or rented within this state from so-called car rental agencies or private parties, to be used in lieu of a privately owned vehicle on official business for the state, shall not exceed the rate provided for the use of a privately owned automobile.

B. The actual cost of leasing or renting an automobile outside of this state to be used on official business for the state shall be reimbursed subject to the approval of the agency head or authorized designee.

C. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection B of this section, authorized persons traveling on official state business outside this state shall be authorized to use rental cars to reach a destination in lieu of commuter airplanes. Provided, however,

reimbursement for cars rented to reach the destination shall not exceed that which is provided for using a commuter airplane.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
