BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 73 O.S. 1991, Section 15, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 15. ~~The~~ Except as otherwise provided by law, the
custody, supervision, and control of all work or material required
in and about the Capitol building, ~~the~~ grounds, and appurtenances
~~thereof~~ shall be exercised by the ~~Director of Public Affairs who~~
Department of Central Services which shall make all requisitions for
supplies, repairs, ~~or~~ and material required in the heating,
lighting, plumbing, ventilation, and operation of the Capitol
building ~~and~~ grounds, and appurtenances. ~~The Office of Public~~
~~Affairs shall prepare and put in order, for the opening of each~~
~~legislative session, the House Chamber and committee rooms at the~~
~~request of and subject to the supervision of the person designated~~
~~by the Speaker of the House of Representatives to have the care,~~
~~custody, and control of said Chamber, committee rooms and property~~
~~of the House, as provided for in Section 72 of this title and shall~~
~~prepare and put in order the Senate Chamber and committee rooms at~~

~~the request of and subject to the supervision of the Secretary of the Senate. The Director of Public Affairs shall also employ and have supervision of the janitors, engineers, mechanics, telephone operators, and visitors' attendants, except those employed and paid subject to the jurisdiction of the two houses of the State Legislature.~~

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
