

ENGROSSED SENATE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 247 of Title 37, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No person shall knowingly sell, deliver or furnish low-point
beer to an intoxicated person. Any person violating the provisions
of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon
conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five
Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for
a term of not more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and
imprisonment. Such violation shall be additional grounds for
revocation of any license or permit for the sale of low-point beer
as and in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
