BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF LIBRARIES

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Libraries from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the Department of Libraries shall budget all funds in the following categories:

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-seven Thousand Twenty-seven Dollars (\$57,027.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. The Oklahoma Department of Libraries for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Secretary of State from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Secretary of State by law.

SECTION 5. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the Secretary of State shall budget all funds in the following categories:

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the Secretary of State from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the expenses of the Office of Administrative Rules.

SECTION 7. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Secretary of State by law shall be set by the Secretary of State. The Secretary of State, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 8. Appropriations made by this act for the operation of the Oklahoma Department of Libraries or the Secretary of State, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997 (hereafter FY-97) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998 (hereafter FY-98). Funds budgeted for FY-97 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1997, and must be expended by November 15, 1997. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1997, and not budgeted for FY-98, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-98 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1998, and must be expended by November 15, 1998. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1998, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. The appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-97, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-98, after the Department of Libraries or the Secretary of State has prepared

and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-97 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 9. This act shall become effective July 1, 1996.

SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
