BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF LIBRARIES

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the Oklahoma Department of Libraries shall budget all funds in the following categories:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-Seven Thousand Twenty-seven Dollars (\$57,027.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. The Oklahoma Department of Libraries for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations except as

may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the Secretary of State shall budget all funds in the following categories:
