BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

STATE ARTS COUNCIL

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the State Arts Council shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
