BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-314 of Title 29, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Wildlife Conservation may sell advertising in any publication, media production or other informational material produced by the Department. All advertising shall be approved by the Director of Wildlife Conservation prior to acceptance for publication or use. The Director shall not approve advertising which relates to a campaign for an elective office or a state or local ballot measure or endorses a candidate for an elective office.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
