

ENGROSSED SENATE
BILL NO. 974

An Act relating to environment and natural resources;
requiring transporters of waste, wastewater or
sludge to develop and maintain manifests; stating
information required on manifests; requiring
manifests for transportation from certain
facilities; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-6-107 of Title 27A, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Department of Environmental Quality shall require that
each person transporting waste, wastewater or sludge subject to the
provisions of this article develop and maintain manifests tracking
the handling and transportation of such waste, wastewater or sludge.
The manifests shall include, but not be limited to:

1. The name and address of the generator of the waste;
2. The location from which the waste is removed;
3. The name and address of the transporter of the waste;
4. The name and address of the treatment facility receiving the
waste; and

5. The quantity of waste transported.

B. The manifests shall be required for the transportation of said wastes from any location or facility, including, but not limited to, treatment works, wastewater treatment systems, pretreatment facilities and water supply systems.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996.
