A Concurrent Resolution creating the Joint Legislative Commission on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building Disaster Response; providing for appointment of members and officers of Commission; authorizing reimbursement for travel expenses; providing for staff assistance; stating duties of Commission; requiring certain report by certain date; and requiring notification to President Pro Tempore of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives of funding needs.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created the Joint Legislative Commission on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building Disaster Response for the purpose of coordinating State response to the disaster. The Commission shall be composed of twenty (20) members to be appointed as follows:

1. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall appoint:

- a. five members from the Oklahoma State Senate, and
- b. four members who represent state law enforcement, city government, and affected business and property owners;

2. The Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives shall appoint:

- a. five members from the Oklahoma House of Representatives; and

- b. four members who represent local law enforcement, county government, and affected business and property owners; and

3. The Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and the Executive Coordinator of the District Attorneys Council shall be members of the Commission.

SECTION 2. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall jointly designate a chair and vice-chair of the Commission.

SECTION 3. Members of the Commission, except legislative members, shall be reimbursed for necessary travel expenses in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act, Section 500.1 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Legislative members shall be reimbursed in accordance with Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 4. Staff assistance for the Commission shall be provided by the Oklahoma State Senate, the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and the Department of Civil Emergency Management.

SECTION 5. The Commission shall:

1. Work to maximize and expedite federal assistance available to state, county, and municipal agencies to respond to losses from the disaster;

2. Work to maximize and expedite private assistance and insurance available for response to the disaster;

3. Survey state, county, and municipal agencies to determine state responsibilities relative to public losses;

4. Issue a report as soon as possible, no later than October 1, 1995, summarizing the funding obligations of the state; and

5. If funding to meet the needs rising from the disaster is required prior to the scheduled time for convening of the 2nd Session of the 45th Legislature, notify the President Pro Tempore of

the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the amount and timing of the funding needs.
