A Concurrent Resolution opposing the sale or other disposition of the Southwestern Power Administration hydroelectric facilities; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, rural electric cooperatives and public power systems serving over one million Oklahomans purchase hydroelectric power from the Southwestern Power Administration; and

WHEREAS, Oklahomans have received billions of kilowatt hours of hydroelectric energy from the Southwestern Power Administration in recent years and this energy served thousands of homes, farms, small businesses, United States Department of Defense installations and industrial establishments; and

WHEREAS, the federal investment in hydroelectric facilities is being systematically repaid to the United States Treasury, with interest, from revenue produced by the sale of hydroelectric power by the Southwestern Power Administration; and

WHEREAS, the sale, transfer, exchange, lease or other disposition of the Southwestern Power Administration hydroelectric facilities will, by the federal government's own projections, cause a cost increase of up to seventy percent (70%) for the one million Oklahomans served by rural electric cooperatives and public power systems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION  
OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature is opposed to the sale,  
transfer, exchange, lease or other disposition of the Southwestern  
Power Administration hydroelectric facilities.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to each member of  
the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation.
