CONCURRENT
RESOLUTION NO. 72

A Concurrent Resolution authorizing the Commission for Human Services to enter into an agreement for construction of a building for certain purpose in Greer County, Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes provides that the board of county commissioners of each county shall furnish quarters for local units of the Department of Human Services unless it is determined that adequate or suitable quarters from the county are not available or obtainable; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that existing quarters for local units of the Department of Human Services in Greer County, Oklahoma, are handicap inaccessible and overcrowded, and are thereby inadequate and unsuitable, and as a result the county is unable to comply with its legal obligations pursuant to Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Greer County, Oklahoma, is willing to undertake a project to provide office space to the Department of Human Services through the construction of an annex to an existing Greer County Trust Authority building on property adjacent to the county office building which the county will subsequently lease to the Department; and

WHEREAS, Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes provides that this type of transaction must receive legislative approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT in order to offer accessible and comprehensive services to clients of the Department of Human Services in Greer County, Oklahoma, the Commission for Human Services is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Greer County for the construction of an annex to an existing Greer County Trust Authority building on property adjacent to the county office building to provide office space for the local unit of the Department in Greer County, Oklahoma.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Commission for Human Services and the Board of County Commissioners of Greer County, Oklahoma.
