An Act relating to state government; amending Section 5, Chapter 288, O.S.L. 1994 (74 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 5060.9d), which relates to the Breast Cancer Act Revolving Fund; modifying funds for Breast Cancer Act Revolving Fund; permitting transfer of monies to certain account; authorizing transfer of monies from the Breast Cancer Revolving Fund under certain circumstances; permitting expenditure of certain monies for certain purposes; providing for check-off on state income tax return for Oklahoma Breast Cancer Act; specifying use of generated funds; providing for deposit of monies into Breast Cancer Act Revolving Fund; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 288, O.S.L. 1994 (74 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 5060.9d), is amended to read as follows:

Section 5060.9d A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology to be designated the "Breast Cancer Act Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies ~~apportioned to~~ received by the fund and gifts or donations to the fund. All monies ~~apportioned~~ donated or accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology for the purposes specified in the Oklahoma Breast Cancer Act including but not limited to the compensation of staff and other expenses associated with the implementation of the Oklahoma Breast Cancer Act. ~~Fifty percent (50%) of all monies apportioned to the credit of said fund are hereby~~ Monies from the fund may be transferred to the Breast Cancer Prevention and Treatment Account ~~hereby established~~ and shall be used to carry out the purposes specified in Section 4 5060.9c of this act title. ~~Fifty percent (50%) of all monies apportioned to the fund shall be transferred to the Breast Cancer Research Account hereby established and~~ The monies transferred to the Breast Cancer Prevention and Treatment Account shall be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology for breast cancer research the purposes set forth in the Breast Cancer Act. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer

against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

B. Monies in the Breast Cancer Act Revolving Fund may be expended by the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology for promotional activities to encourage donations to the Breast Cancer Act Revolving Fund by individuals and private businesses or foundations.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5060.9e of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Each state individual income tax return form for tax years commencing after December 31, 1994, and each state corporate tax return form for tax years commencing after December 31, 1994, shall contain a designation as follows, or contain similar wording as space allows on the tax return form:

Oklahoma Breast Cancer Act. Check if you wish to donate from your tax refund ( ) \$2.00, ( ) \$5.00 or ( ) \$\_\_\_\_\_.

B. The monies generated from donations made pursuant to subsection A of this section shall be used by the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology for the purposes specified in the Oklahoma Breast Cancer Act.

C. All monies generated pursuant to subsection A of this section shall be paid to the State Treasurer and placed to the credit of the Breast Cancer Act Revolving Fund.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
