An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-123, which relates to the sale of surplus vehicles; modifying the list of agencies that can purchase surplus vehicles; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-123, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-123. In addition to the authority for public auction under the sanction of the ~~Office of Public Affairs~~ Department of Central Services, the Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized to make available for sale surplus highway patrol vehicles to any state, county or municipal police agencies from a city or town under ten thousand (10,000) population or to any county government for use by the sheriff's department of that county law enforcement agency. Vehicles may be offered for sale only after approval is given in writing by the ~~Office of Public Affairs~~ Department of Central Services and an evaluation is made of each vehicle and a price set by the ~~Office of Public Affairs~~ Department of Central Services. The Department of Public Safety may only receive the amount authorized by the ~~Office of Public Affairs~~ Department of Central Services for the sale of the vehicle.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
