An Act relating to game and fish; amending 29 O.S. 1991, Section 5-409, as amended by Section 7, Chapter 149, O.S.L. 1992 (29 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 5-409), which relates to squirrel hunting; extending the hunting season for squirrels; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 1991, Section 5-409, as amended by Section 7, Chapter 149, O.S.L. 1992 (29 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 5-409), is amended to read as follows:

Section 5-409. A. Except as otherwise provided by law, no person may capture or kill squirrels except between May 15 to January ~~±~~ 31, both dates inclusive, nor shall such person bag or possess more than two (2) day's limit after the second day's hunt. Bag limits shall be set by the Commission.

B. No person may cut down or remove a tree being used as a den or nest by squirrels unless specific permission for such cutting or removal has been given by the owner or lessee of the land.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
