An Act relating to educational entities; making appropriations to the State Board of Education; stating purpose; making appropriation to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation; stating purpose; making appropriations to the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education; stating purpose; amending Section 23 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1764 of the 1st Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to expenditures of certain funds; modifying expenditure of certain scheduled funds; providing for allocation of certain funds; specifying expenditures of certain allocated funds; providing that certain funds be provided on a competitive application basis; stating purpose of certain administrative and support function funds; providing lapse dates; authorizing certain funds to be budgeted after certain date for certain purposes under certain condition; providing effective dates; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Seven Hundred Seventy-one Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-eight Dollars (\$771,388.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the Financial Support of Public Schools.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Mineral Leasing Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Three Hundred Seventy-six Thousand Three Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$376,390.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the Financial Support of Public Schools.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994, the sum of Ninety-seven Thousand Three Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$97,316.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the Financial Support of Public Schools.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the

General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Six Hundred Twenty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-one Dollars (\$622,861.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the Financial Support of Public Schools.

SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of One Million Seven Hundred Twenty-seven Thousand One Hundred Eighty-eight Dollars (\$1,727,188.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the Financial Support of Public Schools.

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Four Million Six Hundred Sixty-eight Thousand Six Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$4,668,612.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to accomplish the support of public school activities by law as provided in paragraph 2 of Section 12 of this act.

SECTION 7. There is hereby appropriated to the State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of Two Hundred Twenty-six Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-two Dollars (\$226,892.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to be expended for Oklahoma Tuition Aid Grants pursuant to the Oklahoma Higher Education Tuition Aid Act.

SECTION 8. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation by law.

SECTION 9. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) to be distributed to the local schools via the equity funding formula to ensure that quality vocational education shall be available to all students regardless of the local resources available in their district.

SECTION 10. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) to be disbursed to the Indian Capital Area Vocational-Technical School to pay for capital improvements to the new Tahlequah campus.

SECTION 11. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) to be disbursed to the Northeastern Oklahoma Area Vocational-Technical School to pay for capital improvements to the Delaware County campus currently under construction.

SECTION 12. AMENDATORY Section 23 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1764 of the 1st Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 23. Beginning July 1, 1995, the support of public school activities by the State Board of Education payable from monies appropriated, reappropriated, redesignated and authorized by Sections 1 and 8 through ~~19~~ 17 of ~~this act~~ Enrolled House Bill No. 1764 of the 1st Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature and

3. The funds appropriated, reappropriated, redesignated and authorized in Sections ~~7, 9, 17 and 22 of this act~~ Enrolled House Bill No. 1764 of the 1st Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature

96, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-97, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-96 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 17. Sections 1 through 5 of this act shall become effective August 1, 1995.

SECTION 18. Sections 6 through 15 of this act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 19. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
