An Act relating to funding public records and information agencies; making appropriations to the Oklahoma Department of Libraries; stating purpose; limiting the salary of the Executive Director; providing budgetary limitations; amending Section 13 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 172 of the 1st Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to appropriations to the Secretary of State; modifying such appropriations; amending Section 15 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 172 of the 1st Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to appropriations to the Secretary of State; modifying such appropriations; providing budgetary limitations; authorizing certain budgeting of appropriations; providing for lapse of funds; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF LIBRARIES

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Libraries from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of Five Hundred Seventy-four Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-eight Dollars (\$574,668.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law.

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-seven Thousand Twenty-seven Dollars (\$57,027.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996. The Oklahoma Department of Libraries for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECRETARY OF STATE

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 13 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 172 of the 1st Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 13. There is hereby appropriated to the Secretary of State from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General

Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of ~~One Hundred Sixty-eight Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$168,480.00)~~ One Hundred Eighty-eight Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$188,525.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Secretary of State by law.

SECTION 4. AMENDATORY Section 15 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 172 of the 1st Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 15. There is hereby appropriated to the Secretary of State from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of ~~One Hundred Thirty-one Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$131,625.00)~~ One Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-five Dollars (\$121,565.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the expenses of the Office of Administrative Rules.

SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Secretary of State by law shall be set by the Secretary of State. The Secretary of State for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act for the operations of the Oklahoma Department of Libraries or the Secretary of State, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996 (hereafter FY-96) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997 (hereafter FY-97). Funds budgeted for FY-96 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1996, and must be expended by November 15, 1996. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1996, and not budgeted for FY-97, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-97 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1997, and must be expended by November 15, 1997. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1997, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-96, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-97, after the Department of Libraries or the Secretary of State has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-96 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 7. This act shall become effective September 1, 1995.
