An Act relating to chief executive offices; making an appropriation to the Office of the Governor; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor; stating purpose; authorizing certain budgeting of appropriations; providing for lapse of funds; and providing an effective date.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the amount of Sixty-six Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars (\$66,267.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Governor by law.

OFFICE OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the amount of Fourteen Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-three Dollars (\$14,923.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Lieutenant Governor by law.

SECTION 3. Appropriations made by this act may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997 (hereafter FY-97) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998 (hereafter FY-98). Funds budgeted for FY-97 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1997, and must be expended by November 15, 1997. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1997, and not budgeted for FY-98, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-98 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1998. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1998, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-97, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-98, after the agencies have prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-97 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective September 1, 1996.
