An Act relating to the Department of Mines; making an appropriation to the Department of Mines; specifying purposes; amending Section 19 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1795 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature; providing for the budgeting of funds in certain categories and amounts; providing for lapse date; requiring budget work program revision; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Mines from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to implement provisions of the Oklahoma Explosives and Blasting Regulation Act.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 19 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1795 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 19. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the Department of Mines shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 3. The appropriation made by this act to the Department of Mines for the operations of the Department may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997 (hereafter FY-97) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998 (hereafter FY-98). Funds budgeted for FY-97 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1997, and must be expended by November 15, 1997. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1997, and not budgeted for FY-98, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal

year. Funds budgeted for FY-98 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1998. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1998, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-97, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-98, after the agencies have prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-97 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective September 1, 1996.
