An Act relating to education services; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education; stating purpose; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for inmate literacy.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 1996.
