An Act relating to Oklahoma historical societies;  
authorizing the Oklahoma Historical Society to  
sponsor and administer state participation in the  
National History Day competition; providing for  
certain contingencies for such action; providing  
for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5.3 of Title 53, unless there is  
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Historical Society may sponsor and administer state  
participation in the annual National History Day competition  
contingent upon the availability of necessary funding and the  
approval of the Oklahoma Historical Society Board of Directors.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
