A Concurrent Resolution authorizing the Commission for Human Services to enter into a certain lease/purchase agreement for certain office space; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires the board of county commissioners of each county to furnish quarters for local units of the Department of Human Services unless it is determined that adequate or suitable quarters from the county are not available or obtainable; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Washington County, Oklahoma, does not have adequate resources to meet its legal obligation; and

WHEREAS, Washington County, Oklahoma, is undertaking a project to provide office space to the Department of Human Services through the building/purchase of an office building which it will subsequently lease/purchase to the Department of Human Services; and

WHEREAS, at the end of the ten-to-fifteen-year lease period, the Department of Human Services will have an option to purchase the office building; and

WHEREAS, Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires that this type of transaction must receive legislative approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT in order to offer accessible and comprehensive services to clients of the Department of Human Services from Washington County, Oklahoma, the Commission for Human Services is hereby authorized to enter into a lease/purchase agreement with Washington County to provide office space to the Department of Human Services for the location of the local county office of the Department of Human Services in Washington County, Oklahoma.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Commission for Human Services and the board of county commissioners of Washington County, Oklahoma.
