A Joint Resolution approving certain emergency rules of the
Department of Human Services; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 250.2 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma
Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to approve the
implementation of any rule while under review by the Legislature,
establish policy and designate the method for rule promulgation; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services adopted emergency
rules on April 25, 1995, to become effective July 1, 1995, relating
to developmental disabilities services; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Legislature recognizes the benefits
of the proposed emergency rules to individuals with mental
retardation or developmental disabilities who utilize developmental
disabilities services, and the importance of final promulgation of
these rules to those individuals and their families.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
AND THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services proposed emergency
rules OAC 340:100-5-1, OAC 340:100-5-20, OAC 340:100-5-22 and OAC
340:100-5-25 relating to developmental disabilities services, are
hereby approved until July 14, 1996, or until superseded by the
promulgation of permanent rules.

SECTION 2. The Oklahoma State Legislature hereby directs the
Department of Human Services to immediately initiate permanent
rulemaking action relating to developmental disabilities services
and to submit the resulting permanent rules to the Legislature and
the Governor on or before January 1, 1996.

SECTION 3. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to
distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor, the Department
of Human Services, and the Editor of "The Oklahoma Register".
