RESOLUTION NO. 1077

A Joint Resolution relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating certain road the "Pawnee Bill Memorial Highway"; directing Department of Transportation to place suitable markers; providing for noncodification; and directing distribution.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. U.S. Highway 64 from the city of Pawnee west to U.S. Highway 177 shall be designated the "Pawnee Bill Memorial Highway" as a lasting tribute to Major Gordon W. Lillie, known as "Pawnee Bill", the famous frontiersman and showman of wild west shows. The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing the name.

SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. Copies of this resolution shall be distributed to the Secretary and Director of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation.
