RESOLUTION NO. 1022 By: Boyd (Laura)

A Resolution proclaiming the week of April 17-21, 1995, as Oklahoma Archeological Survey Week; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Archeological Survey, created by legislative act in April, 1970, is this year observing its twenty-fifth year of distinguished service to Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the Survey has worked tirelessly and effectively to protect and preserve our state's cultural resources, holding them in trust as a precious heritage for our children; and

WHEREAS, the agency has achieved nationwide respect for its management of these cultural resources, its innovative educational programs and the quality of its published research; and

WHEREAS, the Survey, uniquely among state archeological agencies, has worked closely with advocates, encouraging and training them in archeologists' skills, so that their activities benefit and complement its own; and

WHEREAS, the Survey staff, under sound direction, has exceeded the expectation of its legislative creators, providing benefits and services not envisioned in 1970; and

WHEREAS, the efforts and achievements of the Archeological Society have provided and will continue to bring pride to the people of this Great State and deserve recognition and commendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the week of April 17-21, 1995, be designated "Oklahoma Archeological Survey Week" in recognition of the Survey's indispensable service to the people of Oklahoma.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Oklahoma Archeological Survey and the Oklahoma Anthropological Society, Inc.
