RESOLUTION NO. 1031 By: Sadler, Kirby and Boyd (Laura)

A Resolution honoring World War II veterans; recognizing Aerospace America as an official statewide celebration; declaring June 16-18, 1995, as "World War II Veterans Recognition Days" in Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, 1995 marks the 50th anniversary of the end of World War II; and

WHEREAS, many Oklahoma men and women joined the armed forces and courageously served their country during World War II; and

WHEREAS, 7,452 Oklahomans bravely fought and valiantly gave their lives for their nation during this war so that Americans and Oklahomans alike would enjoy freedom and democracy; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the great State of Oklahoma proudly honor all of the World War II veterans and pay tribute to them for all of their heroic sacrifices; and

WHEREAS, Aerospace America, an annual air show held at Will Rogers World Airport, is being sponsored by the Oklahoma City All-Sports Association on June 16-18, 1995; and

WHEREAS, Aerospace America has volunteered to host and honor all World War II veterans at this special event; and

WHEREAS, Aerospace America will also provide World War II veterans with free entry into Aerospace America 1995 to view the renowned U.S. Navy Blue Angels, the acclaimed World War II pilot, Lefty Grander, who will be flying his P-38 "White Lightning", and other interesting ceremonies and aircraft demonstrations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives justly honors all World War II veterans.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives recognizes Aerospace America as an official statewide celebration honoring all World War II veterans.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives declares June 16-18, 1995, as "World War II Veterans Recognition Days" in Oklahoma.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Kathy Jones, Show Director of Aerospace America.
