A Resolution declaring July 27, 1995, as Korean War Veterans Day; commending Korean War Veterans; honoring memory of individuals killed during Korean War; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, from 1950 to 1953 the United States of America was involved in a war on the Korean peninsula; and

WHEREAS, during the course of the Korean War 54,246 Americans lost their lives defending the principles of democracy; and

WHEREAS, during the course of the Korean War 103,284 Americans were wounded while upholding the intrinsic right to freedom; and

WHEREAS, during the course of the Korean War 8,177 Americans were declared missing in action, leaving an unsettling emptiness in the hearts of loved ones and comrades-in-arms; and

WHEREAS, during the course of the Korean War 7,140 Americans were held captive as prisoners of war enduring unimaginable hardships; and

WHEREAS, all of those Americans answered the call to defend a country they never knew and a people they never met; and

WHEREAS, to honor those brave Americans, a Korean War Veterans Memorial is being constructed in Washington, D.C.; and

WHEREAS, the Korean War Veterans Memorial will be dedicated on July 27, 1995.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives declares July 27, 1995, as Korean War Veterans Day.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives commends the efforts of all Korean War Veterans.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives honors the memory of all those who lost their lives during the Korean War.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor, the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma and the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs.
