

ENROLLED HOUSE  
RESOLUTION NO. 1053 By: Deutschendorf

A Resolution requiring measure numbers and short titles on measures considered by the Oklahoma House of Representatives be made available to citizens via the Internet.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma House of Representatives encourages citizen input in all measures considered by the Oklahoma House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, computers and systems like the Internet have become an integral part of the information world; and

WHEREAS, systems like the Internet allow citizens to be selective and focused on areas of interest without expending time and energy on filler material; and

WHEREAS, each measure introduced in the Oklahoma Legislature is accompanied by a short title giving a short description of the subject of the measure; and

WHEREAS, these short titles would be helpful to citizens wishing to keep in touch with the legislation being considered in the Oklahoma House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, for the most informative citizen input, it is necessary that measures considered by the Oklahoma House of Representatives be indexed on the House Internet Home Page with the measure number and short title and such be made available for scanning and review by the citizens of Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 45TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT measures considered by the Oklahoma House of Representatives be indexed on the House Internet Home Page with the measure number and short title and such be made available for scanning and review by the citizens of Oklahoma.
