WHEREAS, H.E. "Gene" Rainbolt served his country during the Korean War as an intelligence officer of the 981st Field Artillery Battalion and received the Bronze Star Medal and Army Commendation Medal; and

WHEREAS, H.E. "Gene" Rainbolt has built a statewide banking organization, starting with Federal National Bank in Shawnee in 1967, then forming United Community Corporation to service banks throughout Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, BancFirst was created in 1989 from the banks that comprised United Community Corporation; and

WHEREAS, BancFirst has grown to serve 26 Oklahoma communities and has become Oklahoma's largest state-chartered bank; and

WHEREAS, BancFirst, in 1996, became the first state-chartered bank to have more than one billion dollars in assets; and

WHEREAS, H.E. "Gene" Rainbolt has been a leader for the economic development of Oklahoma through his past service as Chairman of the Oklahoma State Chamber of Commerce and President of the Oklahoma Bankers Association; and

WHEREAS, H.E. "Gene" Rainbolt has given of his time to the State of Oklahoma by having served on the Oklahoma Highway Commission, as Chairman and co-founder of the Oklahoma Development Authority, and as Vice Chairman, original member and co-founder of Oklahoma Futures; and

WHEREAS, H.E. "Gene" Rainbolt continues to serve Oklahoma today as Chairman of the Board of Managers of the State Insurance Fund; and

WHEREAS, H.E. "Gene" Rainbolt continues to give his time to help numerous private organizations, serving as Director for the Oklahoma Academy for State Goals, Oklahoma Medical Research Foundation, the Oklahoma Foundation for Excellence, University of Oklahoma Associates Council, the Oklahoma Zoological Society and the Moran Museum.
